# AIMS

The Santorio Fellowship for Medical Humanities and Science aims at encouraging cooperation amongst scholars across the Europe and is awarded each year to students (MA and PHD) and early career researchers whose interests in the field of Medical Humanities are particularly strong and well recorded.

For the academic year 2017-2018, the scheme will support participants to the international summer school The Kiln, the Alembic, and the Clockwork. Early modern representations of the body and its changing matter (Pisa, 29-31 March 2019) organised by Dr Fabrizio Bigotti and Dr Fabiola Zurlini.

#### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

5 fellowships, worth of € 500 each (€ 300 as travel grant + gratuity of € 200 to join the summer school) will be offered throughout by means of an application process. Applicants should send a Cover Letter, a CV (max 2 pages) and a reference letter to:
